For 60 million years black rhinoceros have wandered the savannahs and bushveld of Africa.

Today their numbers have stabilized, thanks in part to improved anti-poaching, tribal education and reduction in the illegal export trade of dagger horns to the Yemen, and to Asia where they have been used for traditional medicines for over 2,000 years.

However, poaching is still a reality. A poacher in Africa can make more by selling a single horn to a trader than he can in five years from his normal income as a farmer.

Save's aim is to assist in the conservation of endangered African wildlife by raising funds for valuable equipment and services to worthy conservation projects. Our main priority is the fight to save the Black Rhinoceros from extinction.
